

# Study travel to Kyoto, summer 1999

## Zen aesthetics and tea aesthetics

### Sunday, August 29th.

- 7.15 Departure from Asahikawa
- 15.00 (approximately) arrival Kyoto
- Taxi to *Kiyomizu-dera*, view over the city
- \* Walk to *Higashiyama Youth Hostel*, passing *Sanneizaka* and *Ninenizaka*

### Monday, August 30th.

- \* 10.00 / 11.00 *Katsura Rikyu*, roji and park garden, tea pavilions: *Shokin-tei*, *Shoi-ken*, *Shoko-ken*, *Geppa-ro* etc.
- 13.00 *Tenryu-ji*, shakkei garden by Muso Kokushi
- 15.00 *Myoshin-ji*, main axis and *Myoshin-ji Hojo*, pavement design and structure of a major temple
- 16.00 *Taizo-in*, Muromachi garden and recent garden by Nakane Kinsaku

### Tuesday, August 31st.

- \* 9.30 *Omote Senke*, roji and sukiya architecture, *Fushin-an* (Sen Sotan) and *Zangetsu-tei*
- 11.45 *Toji-in*, pruned azalea garden and the tea pavilion *Seiren-tei*
- 12.00 Lunch on the way to Ryoan-ji
- 12.45 *Ryoan-ji*, the Muromachi *kare sansui* garden
- \* 14.00 *Ninna-ji*, (1.500 yen) shinden architecture, and the tea pavillons *Mito-tei* and *Ryokaku-tei*
- 15.45 *Kinkaku-ji*, the Muromachi villa (and/or *Koetsu-ji*, open to 17.00, tea pavilions at the Hon'ami Koetsu estate)  
Eventually a walk through *Nishijin*

### Wednesday, September 1st.

- *Nijo-jo*, representative architecture of the Edo shogunate
- \* 11.00 *Sento Gosho*, sukiya architecture and the Edo stroll park (group a)
- (\* *Shin Takamatsu: Origin I, II & III*)
- 13.30 *Ryogen-in*, early shoin architecture, tsubo niwa, Shigemori south garden and north garden ascribed Sesshu
- 15.00 *Koho-an*, sukiya architecture by Kobori Enshu, including the tea room *Bosen*
- *Daitoku-ji Hojo* and main axis

### Thursday, September 2nd.

- 9.00 *Daisen-in*, early shoin architecture and the Muromachi *kare sansui* garden
- \* 10.00 *Shinju-an*, Muromachi architecture, Murata Shuko gardens, Ikkyu, tea room *Teigyku-ken* by Kanamori Sowa
- \* 11.00 *Daitoku-ji Hojo*, garden and hojo
- 12.00 *shojin ryori* lunch inside Daitoku-ji
- 14.00 *Koto-in*, roji and garden, the tea room: *Shoko-ken* by Hosokawa Sansai
- \* 16.00 *Zuiho-in*, the early shoin, gardens and tea room: *Heisei-no-Tai-an* (with tsubo-no-uchi) copy of Rikyu's Tai-an

- 14.30 *Shisen-do*, sukiya architecture and garden by Ishikawa Jozan
- (eventually) *TAK* by David Chipperfield
- 16.00 Tadao Ando: *Garden of Fine Arts* modern concrete garden
- Fashion Street, architecture by Shin Takamatsu and Tadao Ando
